**Wilmington Trust Moves Atlanta Office to Terminus**  
*New space provides room for growth*

Atlanta, GA, December 4, 2007 – Wilmington Trust announced that it has moved its Atlanta office to the new Terminus 100 building in the heart of Buckhead.

Two Wilmington Trust groups, Wilmington Trust FSB, Georgia and Wilmington Trust Investment Management, have a total of more than 22,500 square feet of premium office space on the 27th story, the uppermost floor of the building. Terminus 100, with its distinctive pyramid-shaped top that spans six additional stories, is located at 3280 Peachtree Road. The new office will allow room for growth of up to 80 Wilmington Trust staff members.

“Our new location in Terminus 100 will give us room to expand as Wilmington Trust grows in Atlanta,” said Robert M. Balentine, chairman and CEO of Wilmington Trust Investment Management. “It also gives us the opportunity to have all of our people working together on a single floor and allows us to host client meetings in an appropriate setting.”

Wilmington Trust moved on Monday, December 3 to its new space in Terminus 100, where it will entertain clients and friends at an office opening reception in late February. The company’s former office was in The Pinnacle Building in Buckhead.

Terminus 100 is part of a 10-acre complex owned, developed, and managed by Cousins Properties Incorporated. The building contains 582,000 square feet of office space above a retail base on the ground level. Design architect Duda/Paine Architects, LLP, provided original plans for the building, while the architect of record is HKS, Inc. The three architectural firms who designed Wilmington Trust's space in the tower were A-Squared Inc., Hendrick, and Bradberry & Kheradi.
